



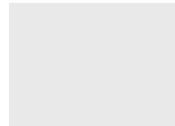

About Our Program

The BGC-YP was created two years ago to provide youth shooters an opportunity to learn the sport of trapshooting in a safe, learning environment.

The program is headed by Head Coach Mark Stevens, an NRA/ATA registered coach and co-recipient of the ATA's 2008 Coach of the Year award. Together with Bruce Bartl, BGC President Wally Shelstad and a group of dedicated volunteer coaches, more than 70 youth shooters have attended the program in a two year period.

About Our Club

The Buffalo Gun Club (BGC) was founded in 1970 by an avid group of local trapshooters.

BGC is open to the public year round, and offers annual memberships entitling members and their families to shoot at reduced rates.

The Buffalo Gun Club is located just 1/4 mile east of Target on Hwy 55. It is on the north side of the highway.

AIM -- Academics, Integrity and Marksmanship

This year the BGC-YP is proud to partner with AIM, the official Youth program of the Amateur Trapshooting Association. Members of AIM will enjoy the thrill of shooting registered competition on a level playing field either as a team or as an individual.

The purpose of AIM is to provide a safe and positive experience with firearms and registered trapshooting for youth, elementary school through college age. AIM encourages good sportsmanship and personal responsibility through competition while establishing the foundation to make trapshooting a lifelong avocation.



What Do I Need to Participate?

We realize all youth who want to try trapshooting for the first time may not have a gun to use. BGC and many coaches have loaner guns for participants to use while onsite. We also provide mandatory eye and ear protection if the youth does not have their own. A shooting pouch to hold shells however this can also be borrowed if necessary.

How Do I Sign Up?

Our Youth Program is limited to 40 participants. Registration for youth shooters aged 11-23 is April 14th, 2009 between 6:30-8:00pm at the Buffalo Gun Club. A parent or guardian must attend registration.

The cost for the 12 week program is \$150 and includes 20 rounds of trap, 20 boxes of shells, all instruction and an end of the season party.
