Your \$150 registration fee includes the following:

- 2011 membership for ATA & AIM
- 20 boxes of shells (see below)
- up to 20 rounds of trap at BGC on Tuesday nights only
- protective glasses and earplugs
- a team t-shirt and personal shooting journal
- all coaching instruction and materials as necessary to run the program for 10 weeks

Coach's Notes

We've made a couple of changes to our program to help streamline our Tuesday nights and create a better program. If you've been involved with BGCYP in the past please take note of the following:

- All classes will run from 6:00pm-8:00pm

- No shoot cards will be issued. Our program runs for 10 weeks and offers up to 20 rounds of trap. Missed rounds will not be credited and cannot be made up on a different night.

- All shells will be handed out at the start. Each shooter is responsible for bringing their own shells each week. If you forget, shells are available for purchase at \$6.25/box + tax from the BGC counter.

Thank you in advance, to all shooters and their parents, for your commitment to our program and to trapshooting. It is our goal to coach your youth shooter towards a lifelong participation in this great sport through positive coaching and competition.
